Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays
This offering is only for children going into the 2nd and 3rd grade. The program is Tuesday, Thursday and Friday for three weeks starting June 12, 2007 from 8:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Students will continue to develop and improve decoding skills, fluency and comprehension in Reading. This class will focus on decoding skills with daily practice in phonics, reading for fluency and comprehending information read. Each child will work with the teacher individually, in groups and

with partners. During reading sessions, the child will develop and increase vocabulary, high frequency words, and non decodable words. Get a Summer Enrollment from the Office.
